
DISCOVERY CLASS

The question arose this past week, "How hard is it to find someone to play the organ?" In all truth, there is in fact a national shortage of musicians who can play the organ. Katherine Crosier recently posted an article entitled, "Desperately. Seeking. Organists!" She writes:

"Even though the use of the organ in some churches is passé, there still seems to be a need for organists in others. And it seems that organists are on their way of going the way of the dodo bird, or the dinosaur.

So when an organist goes on vacation, or needs to have surgery, or has a baby, or is otherwise indisposed or out of town, who ya gonna call? In Honolulu, there is such a shortage of capable organists that it's desperation time, otherwise known as 'get creative.'"

Creative for her meant paying airfare to fly in a student from another island to cover her time off. Our options at Trinity are also limited. Josh has a full-time job at a Roman Catholic Church in or near Crystal River and Larry is not always available. So, we are genuinely searching for a relief organist to fill in when Figg needs to take a Sunday off.

Trinity is blessed with not one, but two great organs and the thought of not using them is unbearable. Even with guitars as a back-up, worship is not the same without the organ or a piano. Figg, Margaret and I will continue our search for the right person to fill in when she is away. Please pray for the search, that God will provide the special person we need.
